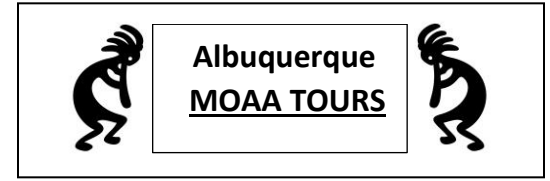

Learn about the diverse topography as well as the sometimes shameful history that is the Republic of South Africa. The Western Cape offers beaches, lush wine lands, craggy cliffs at the Cape of Good Hope, forest and lagoons along the Garden Route, and the city of Cape Town, beneath flat-topped Table Mountain. We continue up the eastern coast and experience different ecosystems in Kruger National Park, as well as Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe.

Included meals are denoted: Breakfast-B, Lunch-L, Dinner-D

DAY 1/2 - We fly to Capetown, South Africa, meet our Tour Director and transfer to the **Southern Sun Cape Sun Hotel**, our hotel for three nights. **D,B,L**

DAY 3 - After a relaxing morning, we get acquainted with Cape Town on a city tour. From **Signal Hill** we enjoy a phenomenal view of the City Centre, the Atlantic Ocean, and **Table Mountain**. We visit the **District Six Museum**, where we hear about the forced removals during the apartheid era in the 1960's. **B,L,D**

DAY 4 - Today we have a full-day Cape Peninsula Tour. We drive to **Hout Bay Harbor** for a view of an authentic fishing village and then drive south on the scenic Chapman's Peak coastal road to the **Cape of Good Hope**. We drive through the **Cape Point Nature Reserve** to reach **Cape Point**, where we take the **Flying Dutchman Funicular** to the top for panoramic views of the Atlantic Ocean. Enjoy **Simon's Town** and the African penguin colony at **Boulder's Beach**. Finally, we visit **Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens**. **B,D**

DAY 5 - We begin our scenic drive to **Oudtshoorn**, where we spend one night at the **Buffelsdrift Game Lodge**, in luxury freestanding tents overlooking a large watering hole for hippos and other game. We stop enroute to visit a local farm school in Barrydale, and learn about the local farming community. **B,D**

DAY 6 - We tour the **Safari Ostrich Show Farm** and museum. Are you up for a ride on an ostrich? This is a great shopping stop as well, with a wide variety of ostrich leather products. We continue our scenic drive along the Garden Route to Knysna where we stay two nights at the charming **Knysna Log Inn**. **B,L,D**

DAY 7 - We cruise across the Knysna River to the **Featherbed Nature Reserve**, with its abundance of plant, bird, and small wildlife. We ride in open trailers to the top of the Western Head to enjoy panoramic views of the town and lagoon. We return to Knysna and visit **Knysna**

Elephant Park, the first facility in South Africa to provide care for orphaned African elephants. We have a free evening to explore charming Knysna. **B,L**

DAY 8 - We continue along the Garden Route to the Port Elizabeth Airport for our flight to King Shaka International Airport in Durban. We meet our new driver and continue to **Durban's Golden Mile** and the **Southern Sun Elangeni & Maharani Hotel**, where all rooms are beachfront on the glorious Indian Ocean. **B,D**

DAY 9 - We visit **Shakaland**, a living museum of the life and times of King Shaka, the influential leader of the Zulu empire. A traditional "kraal" has been authentically restored and we see a performance of Zulu dancing, followed by an exotic "feast" on the grounds of the traditional Zulu homestead. We continue to **Protea Hotel by Marriott Umfolozi River**, where we lodge for one night. **B,L,D**

Day 10 - We head to the **Hluhluwe/Umfolozi Game Reserve**, the oldest nature reserve in Africa, for a 3-hour game drive. You may spot all the Big 5: elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard, and rhino. Also, in abundance are giraffe, hippo, cheetah, and impala. This park has the largest concentration of white rhino in the world. We drive to the Kingdom of Swaziland, for exquisite views of the "**Valley of Heaven**", **Ezulwini Valley**. We spend one night at the **Mountain Inn**. **B,D**

DAY 11 - We drive to **Kruger National Park** for an afternoon game drive. Kruger is one of Africa's largest game reserves, including the "Big 5". We lodge for three nights at **Hippo Hollow Country Estate**. **B,D**

DAY 12 - Today, we have an early morning game drive, as well as an afternoon game drive. We stop for lunch and souvenir shopping at the **Kruger National Park**. Along with the wild animals, there are over 500 species of birds at Kruger. You will be back at your hotel in time to see the hippos come out of the river for supper on the riverbank! **B,D**

DAY 13 - Enjoy a leisurely morning before we visit "**God's Window**", a natural rock formation with spectacular views of the ravine directly below. Almost 6500 feet above sea level, you can see the distant Lebombo Mountains, as well as Kruger National Park. We visit **Bourke's Luck Potholes**, with natural water feature and cylindrical rock sculptures. **B,D**

DAY 14 - We continue to Johannesburg, stopping on the way in the charming town of **Dullstroom** for lunch. We

arrive in Johannesburg and check in to the **Protea Hotel by Marriott Johannesburg Balalaika Sandton**. **B,D**

DAY 15 - We have a full day exploring Johannesburg area and Soweto. After driving past **Nelson Mandela's home** during his final years in the Lower **Houghton Estate district**, we tour **Constitution Hill**, once a notorious prison, reborn as the site of South Africa's Constitutional Court. We visit the **Apartheid Museum** and learn about the rise and fall of apartheid in South Africa. We also visit the "**Mandela House**" in Soweto, where Mandela lived from 1946-1962 and just up the road from Archbishop Desmond Tutu's house. **B,D**

DAY 16 - We fly to Tambo International Airport in Zimbabwe. After exiting Immigration and Customs, we check into the lovely **Ilala Lodge**. (You are less than one mile from the falls at this property and will hear them and even feel the mist on occasion.) This evening, enjoy a **Sundowner Cruise** on the Zambezi River. Besides the relaxing ambience on board the vessel, we will most likely get to see elephants and other game coming to the river for a drink. **B,D**

DAY 17 - We head to majestic, awe-inspiring **Victoria Falls**. Our guide leads us along the misty rain forest trail pointing out the flora and fauna that we encounter. We'll have ample time to wander along the trails and take photographs galore. Relax this afternoon by the pool at **Ilala Lodge** or shop or head back to the Falls. Tonight, we drive into town for a special "**Boma**" dinner, our farewell dinner in beautiful South Africa and Zimbabwe! **B,D**

DAY 18/19 - After flying back to Johannesburg, we begin our journey home, with overnight flights back to the United States. **B,D,B**
