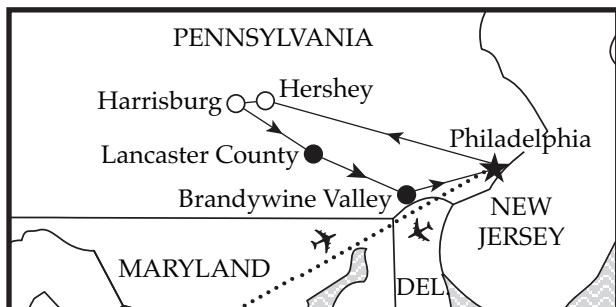
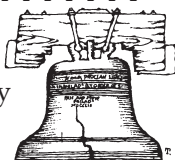

DAY 1 HOME / PHILADELPHIA

We fly to Philadelphia and begin our tour where the United States began. We lodge three nights in the heart of the Historic District at the Wyndham Hotel. The historic buildings and attractions are just a few blocks from our door.

DAY 2 INDEPENDENCE NAT'L HISTORICAL PARK B

We tour Independence Hall, where our founding fathers signed the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution. We learn more about our history at the Independence Visitors Center and also see the Liberty Bell. This afternoon is free time to explore the many attractions near our hotel.

DAY 3 PHILADELPHIA TOUR / BARNES COLLECTION B

We get acquainted with Philadelphia on a guided tour of all of the historical sites including visits to Franklin Court and Christ Church. Then we visit the Barnes Collection. It moved in 2012 from Dr. Barnes' home in the suburbs to a stunning new building in Fairmount Park and quickly became one of the most celebrated museums in the country. It holds the finest collection of Post-Impressionist art with works by Renoir, Cézanne, Van Gogh, Matisse, Picasso, Rousseau, Modigliani, etc. Can you imagine 181 Renoirs?

DAY 4 HERSHEY / HARRISBURG / LANCASTER B

We drive to Hershey in central Pennsylvania where we learn about Milton Hershey and his legacy of chocolate and philanthropy at The Hershey Story. At Chocolate World we learn how chocolate is made and are tempted in its extensive gift shop. We drive to nearby Harrisburg and tour its State Capitol Building, "the handsomest building" President Theodore Roosevelt ever saw. After a guided tour of Harrisburg, we drive to Lancaster County where we lodge two nights.

DAY 5 AMISH EXPERIENCE / THEATER EVENING B,L

Lancaster County is home to the largest Amish population in the USA. At the Plain & Fancy Farm we learn what it means to be Amish as we tour the Amish Country Homestead and School. We drive to the nearby Kitchen Kettle Village where we board buggies for a 4-mile jaunt through the farming countryside. Tonight we view the incredible production of *Joseph at the Sight & Sound Theatre*.



DAY 6 BRANDYWINE VALLEY ATTRACTIONS B

Nemours Mansion is the grandest residence ever constructed in Delaware and its garden is America's finest example of a formal French garden. We tour this breathtaking home designed in the style of a French chateau and filled with rare furniture and great art. At nearby Winterthur Museum & Gardens we see the legacy of Henry Francis du Pont. The museum, once his 175-room home, houses his collection of American decorative arts, considered the world's finest. He developed the gardens with planned informality. We lodge one night near Wilmington, Delaware.

DAY 7 LONGWOOD GARDENS / HOME B

We drive to nearby Longwood Gardens, the world's premier horticultural display garden that was created by Pierre du Pont. Vivid and fragrant flowers delight the senses. It's been a busy and satisfying week exploring so much of Pennsylvania's history and beauty; now we return to the Philadelphia airport for our flight home.
