The undersigned acting as incorporator(s) to form a corporation under the New Mexico Nonprofit Corporation Act (53-8-91 NMSA 1978), adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE: The name of the corporation is The Albuquerque Chapter.

ARTICLE TWO: The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE: The purposes of the Chapter shall be to promote the purposes and objectives of The Retired Officers Association; foster fraternal relations among retired, active, and former officers of the uniformed services and their National Guard or reserve components; protect the rights and interests of active duty, retired, reserve, and National Guard personnel of the uniformed services and their dependents and survivors; provide useful services for members and their dependents and survivors; and serve the community and the nation.

ARTICLE FOUR: If or when the above said corporation is dissolved, all monies and/or assets remaining after all liabilities have been satisfied will be made available to The Retired Officers' Association (TROA) national organization if they remain an IRS tax exempt certified entity. Otherwise all monies and assets will be passed to an IRS tax exempt entity.
