





Sail the clear waters of Scandinavia and the Baltic on this 16-day cruise. Enjoy overnights in cosmopolitan Stockholm and St. Petersburg and explore charming historic city centers in Tallinn and Gdańsk. Visit Helsinki, Berlin, Copenhagen and Bergen, and witness breathtaking scenery from the *Viking Sea* as she glides through majestic Norwegian fjords in the legendary homelands of the Vikings.

DAY 1

We board our overnight flights to Stockholm, Sweden.

DAY 2 B,L,D DAY 3 B,L,D

Our cruise begins in **Stockholm**, an amazing city spread over 14 islands. You may visit 13th-century Gamla Stan, the Vasa, or the Skokloster Castle, enjoy a boat tour or walk the footpaths of Djurgården Island. We depart early afternoon for a cruise through the **Stockholm archipelago**.

DAY 4 B,L,D

Today, in **Helsinki**, we have an **included city tour**. We can visit the 18th-century Suomenlinna Fortress and the Tempeliaukio Church, or the “Rock Church,” a subterranean sanctuary.

DAY 5 B,L,D DAY 6 B,L,D

For two days, we explore majestic **St. Petersburg**. We take an **included tour** that features St. Isaac’s Cathedral, the Peter and Paul Fortress, and Nevsky Prospekt. We can spend both days in the city or journey into the countryside to visit the summer palaces of Russian tsars.

DAY 7 B,L,D

We have all day to discover **Tallinn Old Town** and the sumptuously baroque **Kadriorg Palace**. Be sure to feast on marzipan, for this is the honey and almond confection’s birthplace.

DAY 8 B,L,D

Today, we enjoy our ship. Learn about our upcoming destinations, take a dip in the Infinity Pool, unwind in The Spa, or experience the Snow Grotto and

Sauna. Tonight, consider watching a movie, choosing from three theaters, including one under the stars.

DAY 9 B,L,D

This stop is in **Gdańsk**, one of the richest cities in the Hanseatic League. We can stroll Old Town, and indulge in pierogi dumplings or a glass of gold-flecked Goldwasser - a liqueur created here in the 16th century. Or, explore on our own the medieval Teutonic stronghold of Malbork Castle, the world’s largest brick castle and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DAY 10 B,L,D

From port, we take the **included transfer** through the Mecklenburg region to Germany’s historic capital, **Berlin**, where we spend the day. At our own pace, we can explore the major sights of the Berlin Wall, Alexanderplatz Square, and Checkpoint Charlie.

DAY 11 B,L,D

Today is spent in the Danish capital, **Copenhagen**, which was originally a Viking fishing village founded in the 10th century. With an entire day to explore, we can enjoy the brightly colored houses of Nyhavn (New Harbor), once the home of Hans Christian Andersen, tour Amalienborg Palace, or visit the ornate Kronborg Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the setting of Shakespeare’s *Hamlet*.

DAY 12 B,L,D

Today, we explore **Ålborg**, founded by the Vikings in the late 900s. We can stroll along Nytorv (New Square) and enjoy a variety of architectural styles, including the 14th-century Budolfi Church. Or take in the lively Jomfru Ane Gade, a street lined with trendy cafés and restaurants, and enjoy aquavit, an herb-infused spirit distilled here since the 15th century.

DAY 13 B,L,D

From where our ship berths in **Stavanger**, we have the morning and early afternoon to explore the old

quarter, Gamle Stavanger, which has Europe’s highest concentration of wooden buildings from the 17th and 18th centuries or consider a cruise along the Lysefjord to see Preikestolen, or “Pulpit Rock,” jutting out nearly 2,000 feet above. While ashore, let’s remember to indulge in waffles with cream.

DAY 14 B,L,D

Today, we cruise breathtaking fjords into **Eidfjord**. We ascend Europe’s largest mountain plateau, **Hardangervidda**, in Norway’s largest national park, visit the **Nature Centre**, and perhaps view the Hardangerjøkulen glacier in the distance. We can also marvel at the stupendous 550-foot drop of the Vøringsfossen waterfall.

DAY 15 B,L,D

We arrive in **Bergen**, encircled by majestic mountains, fjords and glaciers. With our ship berthed next to Bryggen wharf, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, we can easily stroll along its waterfront.

DAY 16 B

We say goodbye to the land of Vikings, fjords, and reindeer as we head home to Albuquerque.
