

Propose Veteran Remembrance and Honoring at Veterans Day recognition in Albuquerque, NM:

Beginning 2023: three - four themes in series for three or four sequential years representing each military veteran and service units' period of conflicts and wartime service with an art design used as the program cover for the COA, NM Veterans Memorial Park Foundation, and United Veterans Council of Greater Albuquerque Veterans' Day national and state holiday recognition event.

Theme series for each war period in which the Territory / State of New Mexico contributed individual enlistees, local militia / national guard units from the State to the national wartime theater. The series periods of time that honor military veterans and units will be divided as follows:

- Pre-conflict military veterans and units service in New Mexico
- Combat period and New Mexico military veterans and units serving in theater of conflict and post-conflict in theater duties assigned to New Mexico military veterans and units
- "Coming Home," how veterans were received back in the USA following wartime service
- "Monuments" erected in New Mexico in remembrance of the service and honor to those who served in the wartime period. Also include U.S. national "Monuments" for all those who served in the military in this time frame (Tomb of the Unknown, Arlington National Cemetery, Viet Nam Memorial, Korea Memorial, WWII, WWI, Iwo Jima Memorials, Naval Nuclear submarines, and NM particulars, Buffalo Soldiers, Code Talkers, 200th and 515th Costal Artillery, Nuclear Devices 1-8 designed and built in New Mexico and tested at other locations).

Utilize existing Veterans Service Organizations to create and develop the first design effort beginning with the Indian Wars and Spanish – American War. Enlist the support of the Albuquerque Veterans for Art organization to select one or two of its members who are portrait – graphic design-photographic artist to prepare and publish the annual art design to be used as the Veterans Day printed event program cover page honoring the service of military veterans in peace and war time.

Copyright the artists' design work and provide event publication rights to the COA and to the NM Veterans Memorial Park Foundation publication and distribution rights to turn the cover designs into postcard size items for sale in the NM Veterans Memorial Park Museum and extend the series of art designs into a 5-6 year package of artistic works of Remembrance and Honoring those military veterans and service components from our state.
