Website Issues

- We are abandoning the current website because its current format is unsustainable
 - The current website will be maintained for membership access, to the best of our ability
 - We will not "turn off" the current website until the new site is up and functional (barring any major failures or security concerns on the current website)
 - Recent ALBUMOAA Newsletter article requested membership involvement in development of a new website - no responses to date
- LDD is interested in maintaining or business
 - LDD has historically charged higher than normal per hour (2-3x industry norms), but implies they do not bill for the entire amount of time spent maintaining our website - and evidence over the last 3 months indicates LDD response time to issues is increasing (bad sign)
 - Other hosting sites (HostGator, GoDaddy, BluHost, WP Engine) are available and imply lower cost, but may have hidden fees and questionable service response capability
- Requested a full download of all membership data from LDD to facilitate alternate method of maintaining information while working permanent resolution to website functionality
 - LDD provided a full download of the entire site details (over 500K lines of Excel spreadsheet data, requiring time-consuming parsing to extract relevant information
 - Previous Membership Chair (K. Brown) has maintained a database separate of the website and is currently working off of it, though there may be gaps in the information
- Drafting requirements document; expect to request proposals from at least 4 website design and hosting companies (including LDD) within 3 weeks (07/21/23)

MailChimp Issues

- Current MailChimp relationship is limited
 - We currently have a Free Mail Chimp account which only recognizes 1 user phone number (that is why all the access code texts come to one person); if that person is unavailable, MailChimp is down
 - MailChimp has multiple plans options from the Free account (which we have) to a Premium account for \$350/month; I recommend we obtain an Essentials account at \$13/month which would allow 3 users (3 telephone numbers)
