



Honor Flight of Northern New Mexico is a 501c-3 non-profit organization dedicated to providing Veterans with honor and closure by taking them free of charge to reflect on their memorials in Washington, D.C. Priority is currently being given to World War II and Korean War Veterans as well as terminally ill veterans from other conflicts. The Northern NM Honor Flight receives contributions from our Charitable Giving Program. An adult family member or friend may serve as a guardian to a veteran on the Honor Flight. 31 veterans with their guardians and support staff flew to the BWI airport on Wednesday, June 19th to visit monuments and memorials in Washington, DC.
